1. Connect to the App

1.1 Download and Install the App

1. Search for "Aiper" in the App Store or Google Play, or scan the QR code to download and install the app.



2. Ensure that your mobile operating system is iOS 12.0 or later, or Android 8.0 or later.

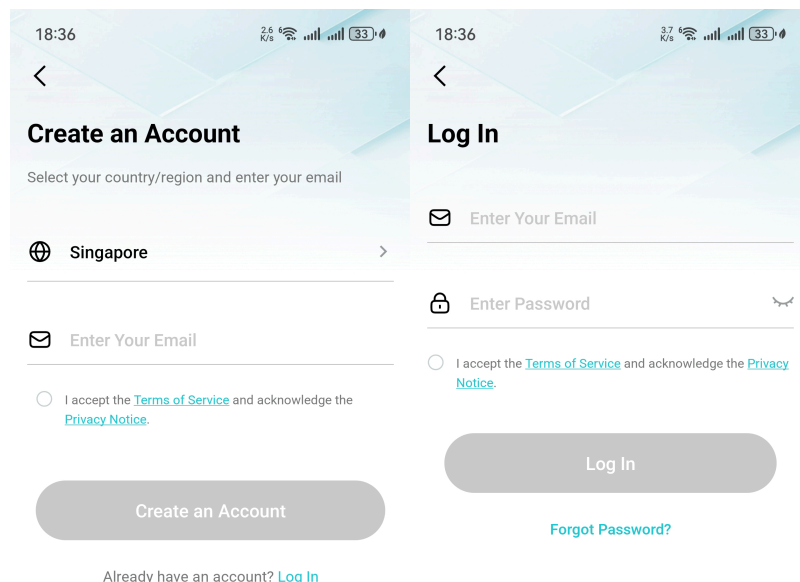
1.2 Registration and Login

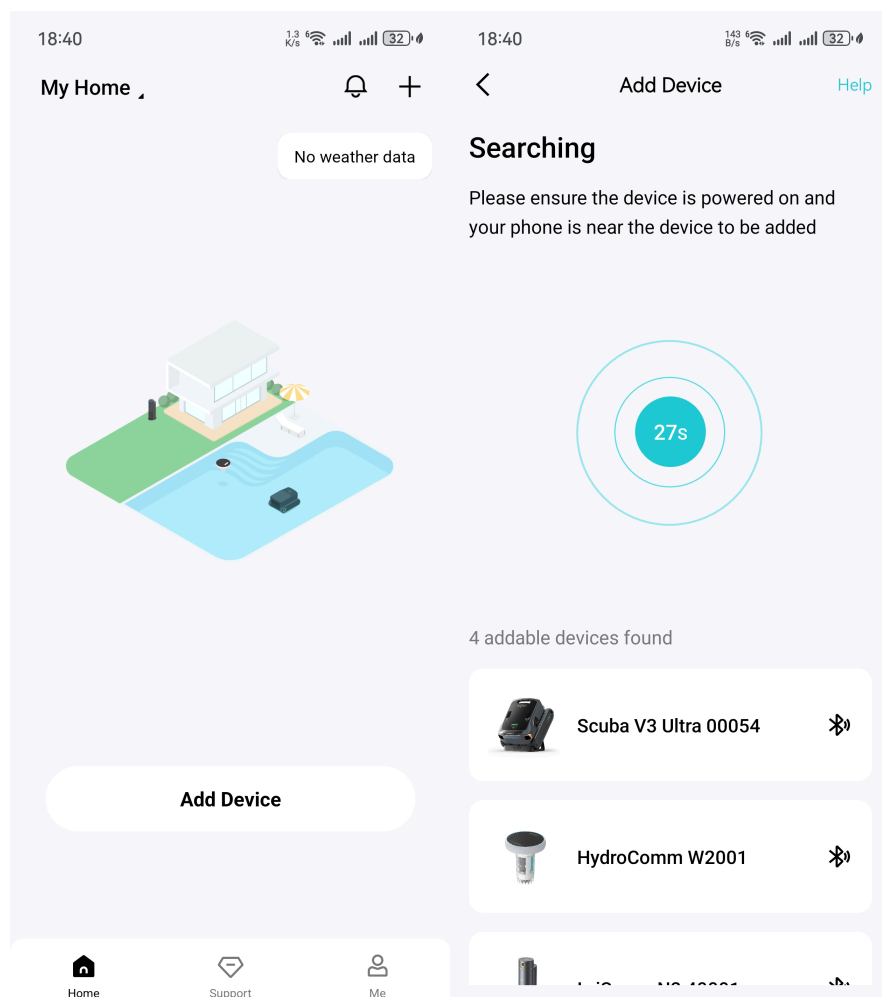

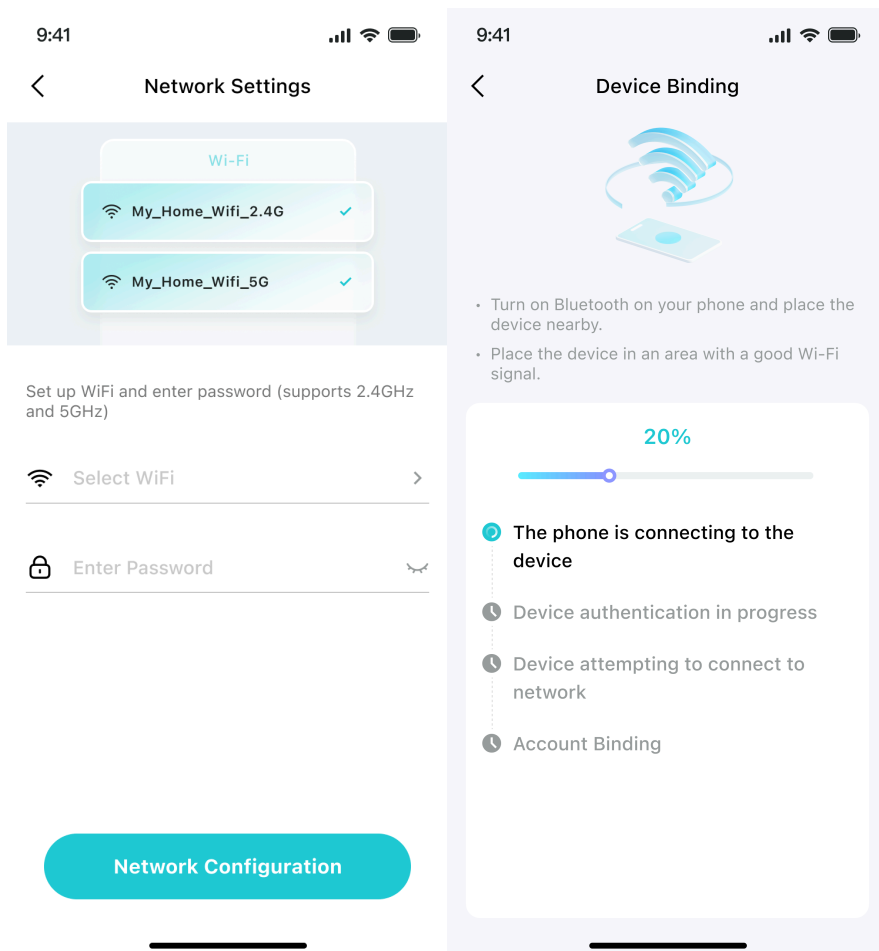

1.3 Device Pairing and Binding

After entering the app, tap the "+" button in the upper right corner, search for nearby devices, and select your device.



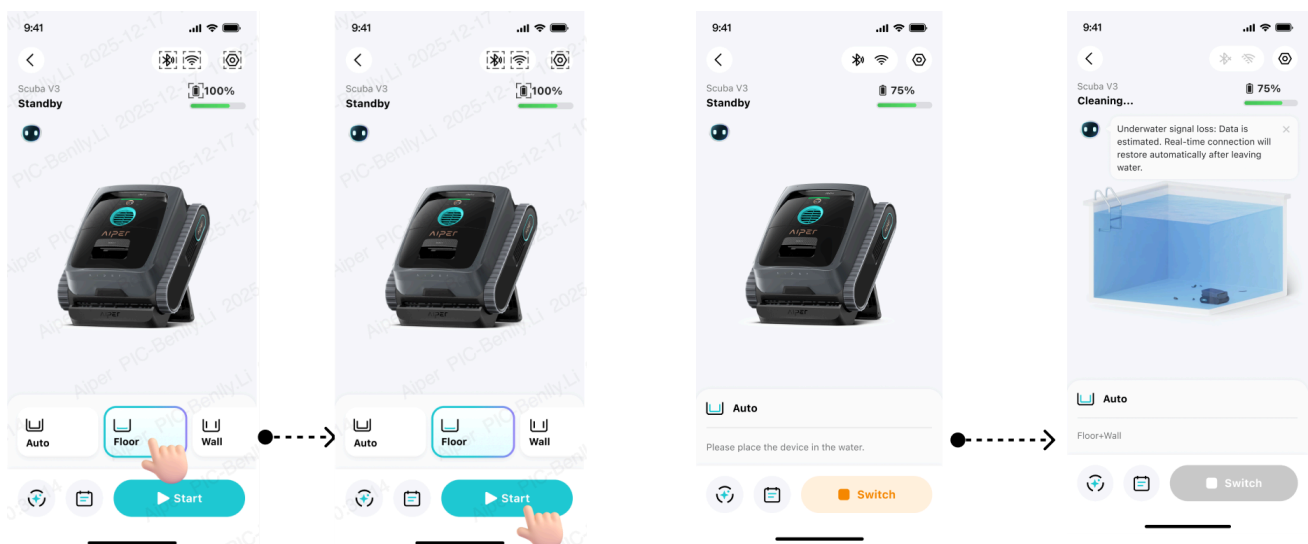
Enter your home Wi-Fi name and password, tap Next, and wait for the network configuration to complete.



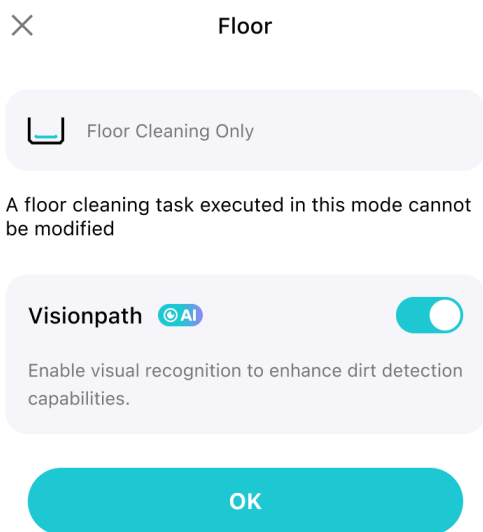
2. App Features

2.1 Quick Start Cleaning

1. Select the appropriate cleaning mode, tap the start button, and place the robot into the water. The robot will then begin the cleaning task.



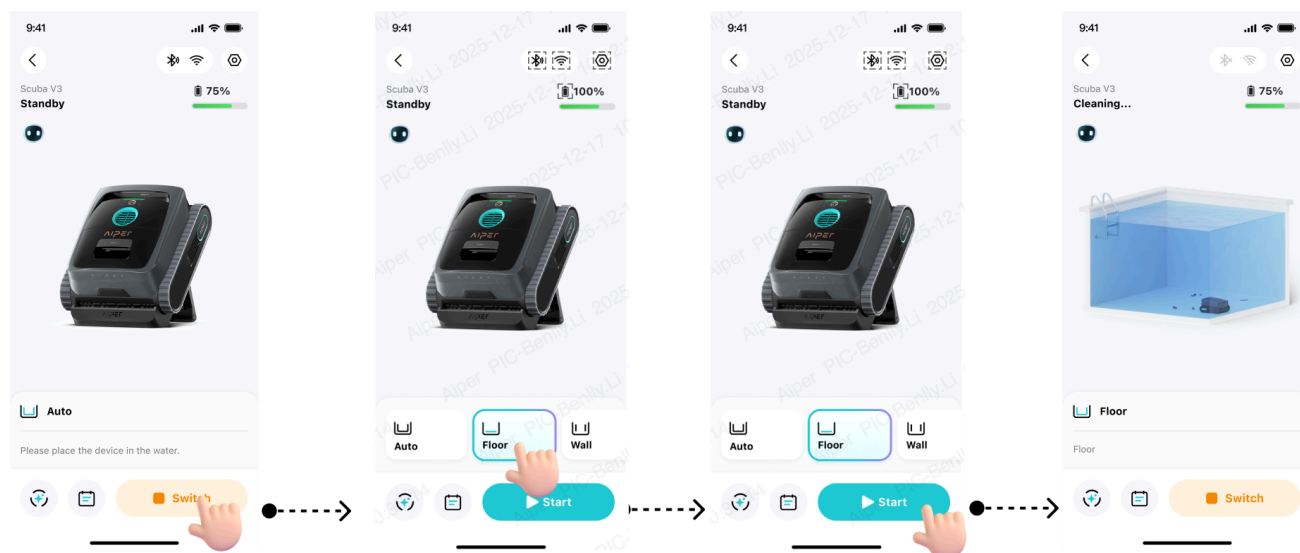
2. When selecting Floor mode, you can choose whether to enable VisionPath. When VisionPath is enabled, the device performs vision-assisted cleaning.



2.2 Switch Cleaning Mode

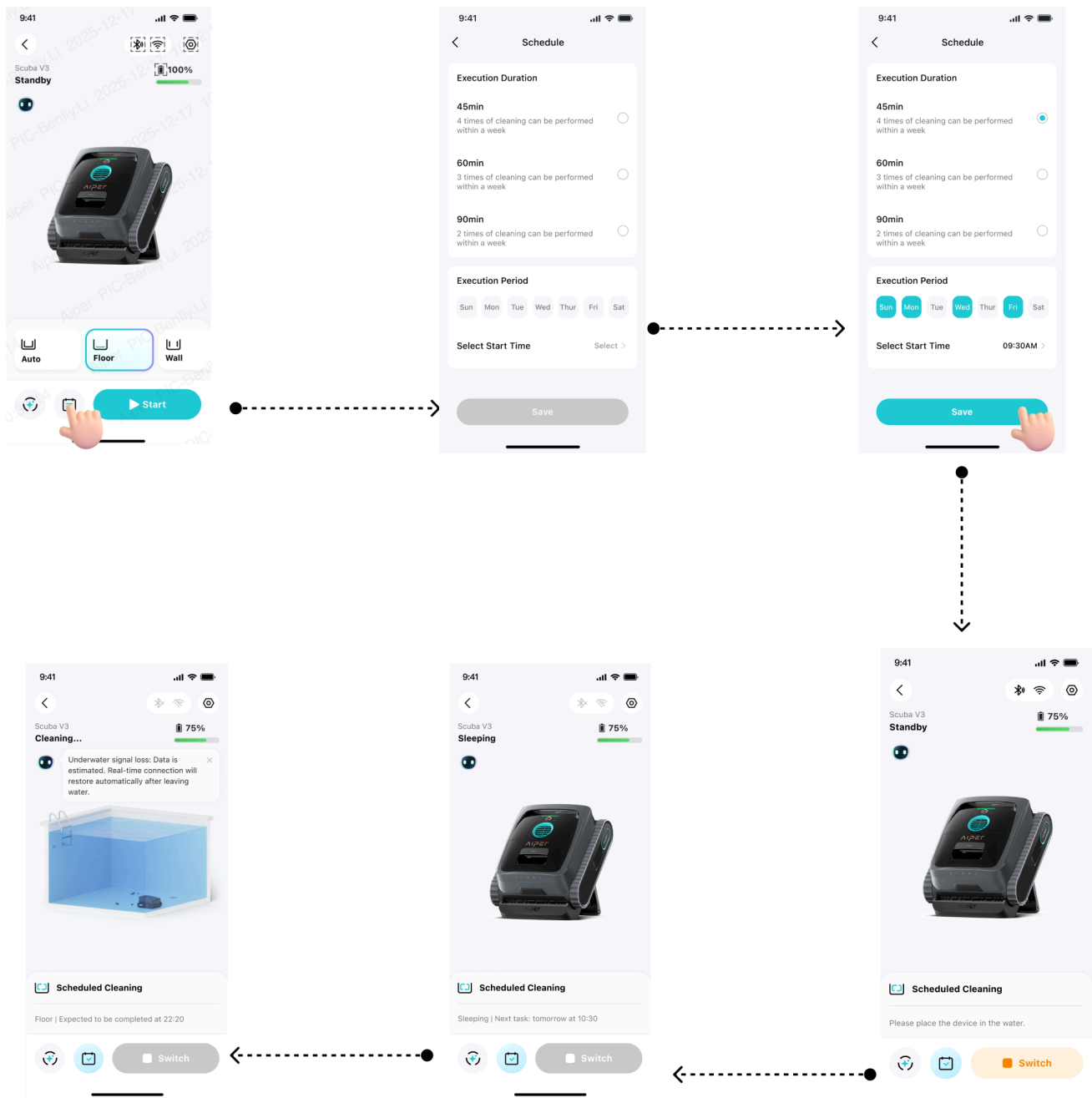
The cleaning mode can only be switched when the robot is on land.

⚠ Caution: Once the robot enters the water, it will lose communication with the app and can no longer be controlled remotely. If you need to switch modes, please take the robot out of the water before proceeding.



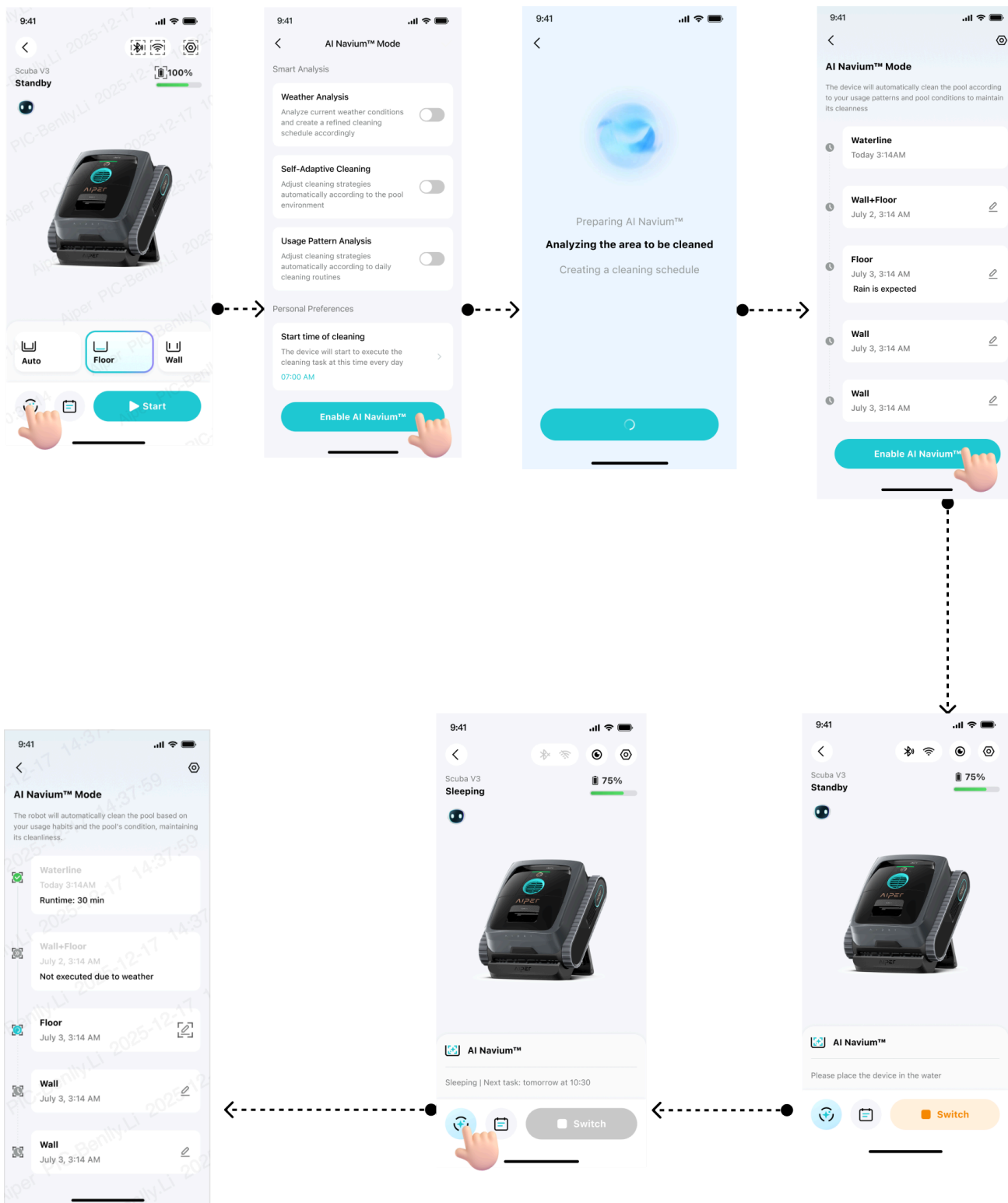
2.3 Custom Cleaning Schedule

The app supports setting a 7-day recurring cleaning schedule. You can select which days within the 7-day period to clean and set the daily start time. After saving, place the robot in the water, and it will automatically begin the scheduled cleaning at the designated time.



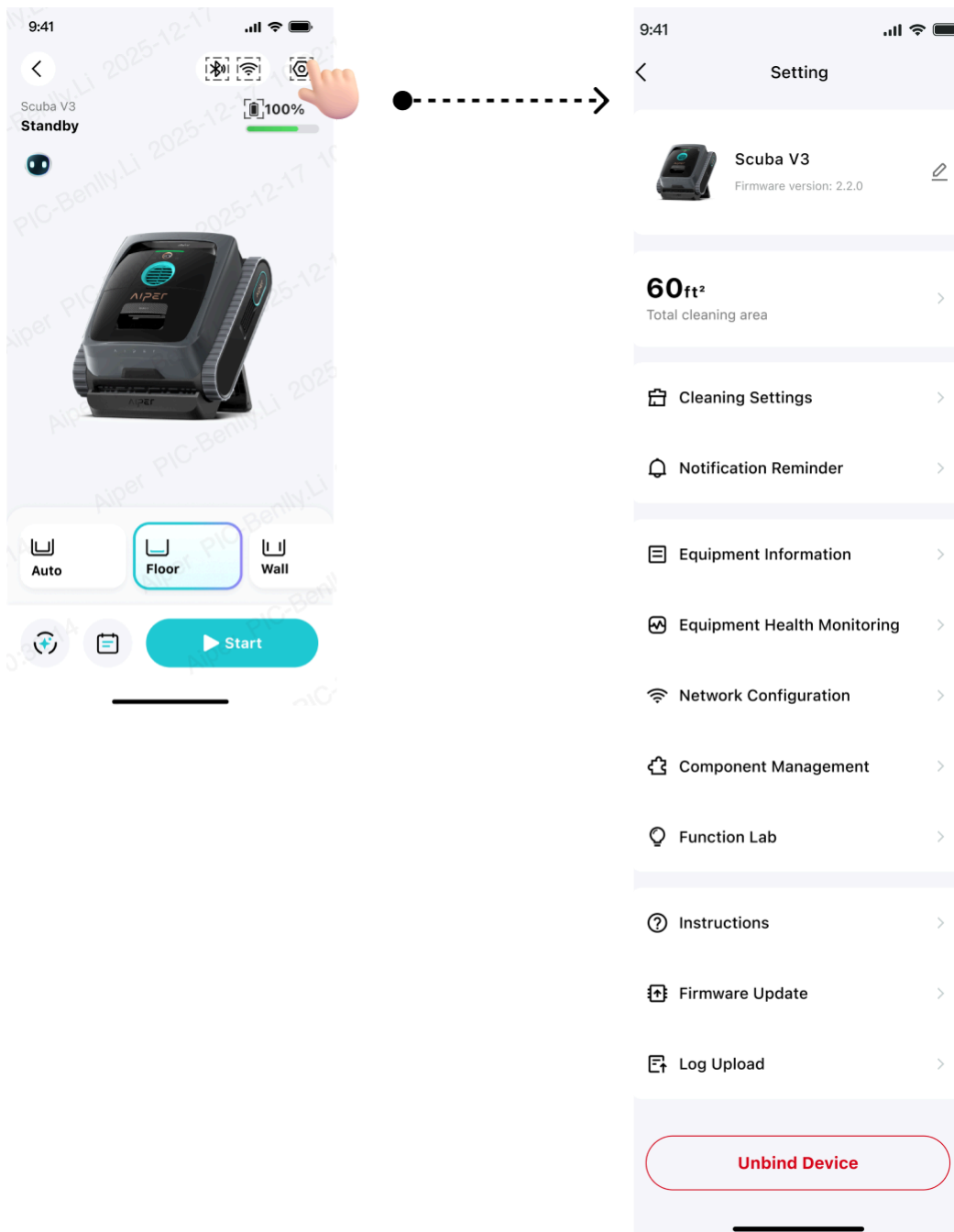
2.4 AI Navium™ Mode

After enabling AI Navium™ Mode, you can configure automatic cleaning settings. Once configured, the robot will generate a cleaning schedule and perform scheduled cleaning automatically to keep the pool clean.



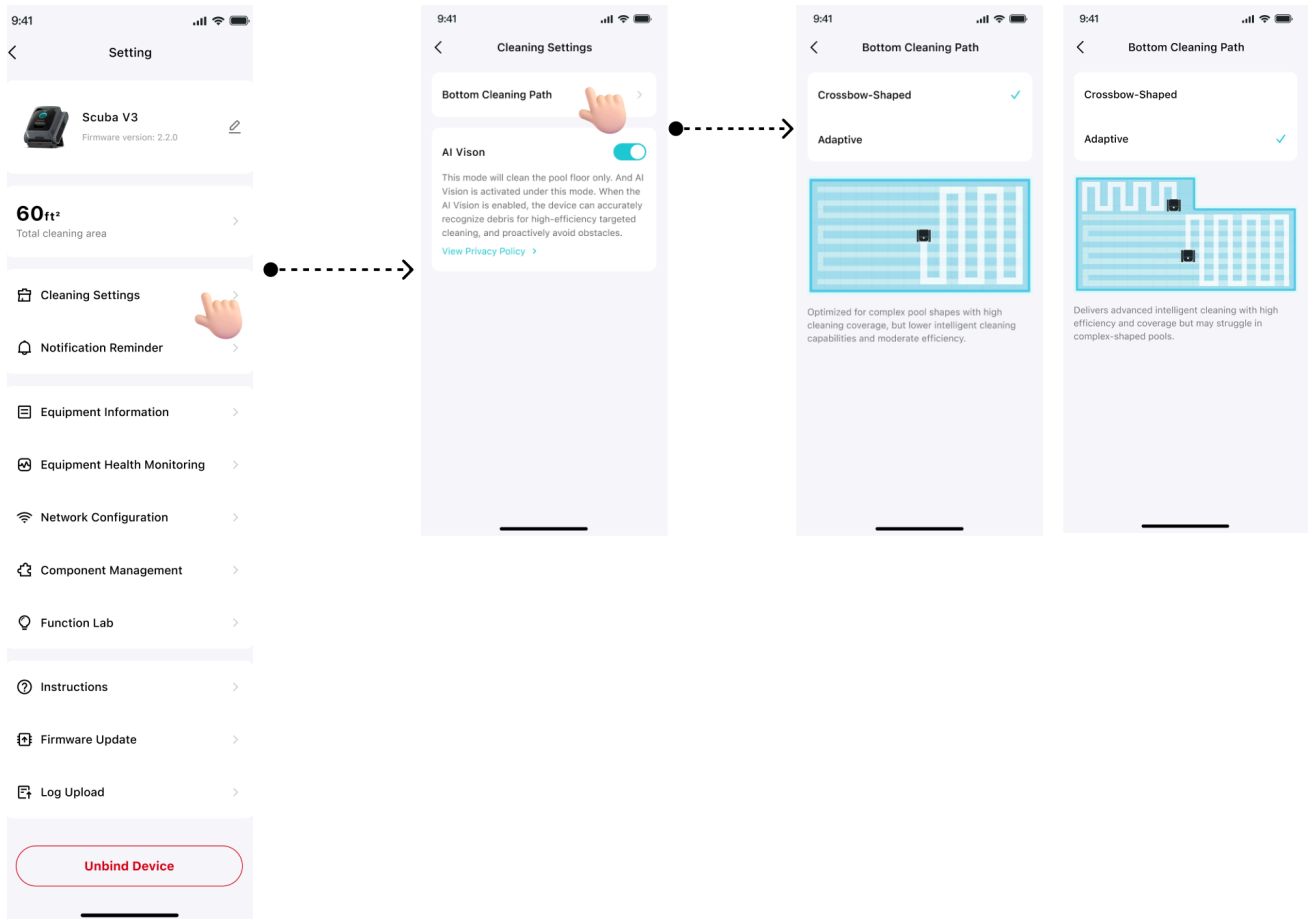

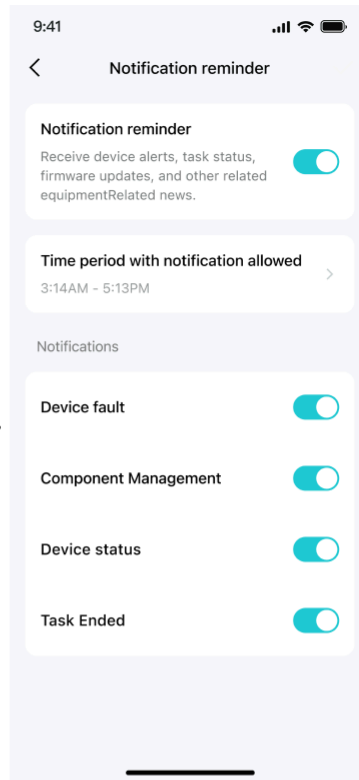
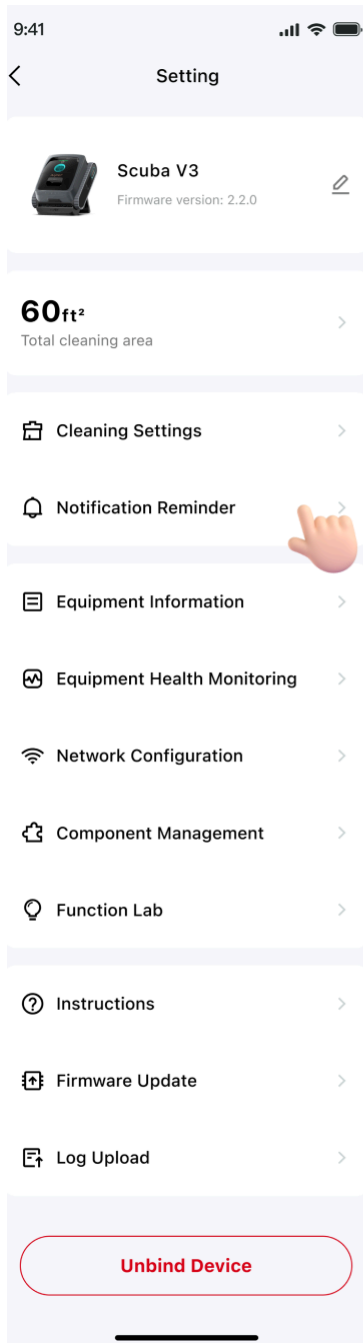
3.2 Cleaning Settings

You can change the cleaning strategy for the device in Cleaning Settings, and also enable or disable the camera here.



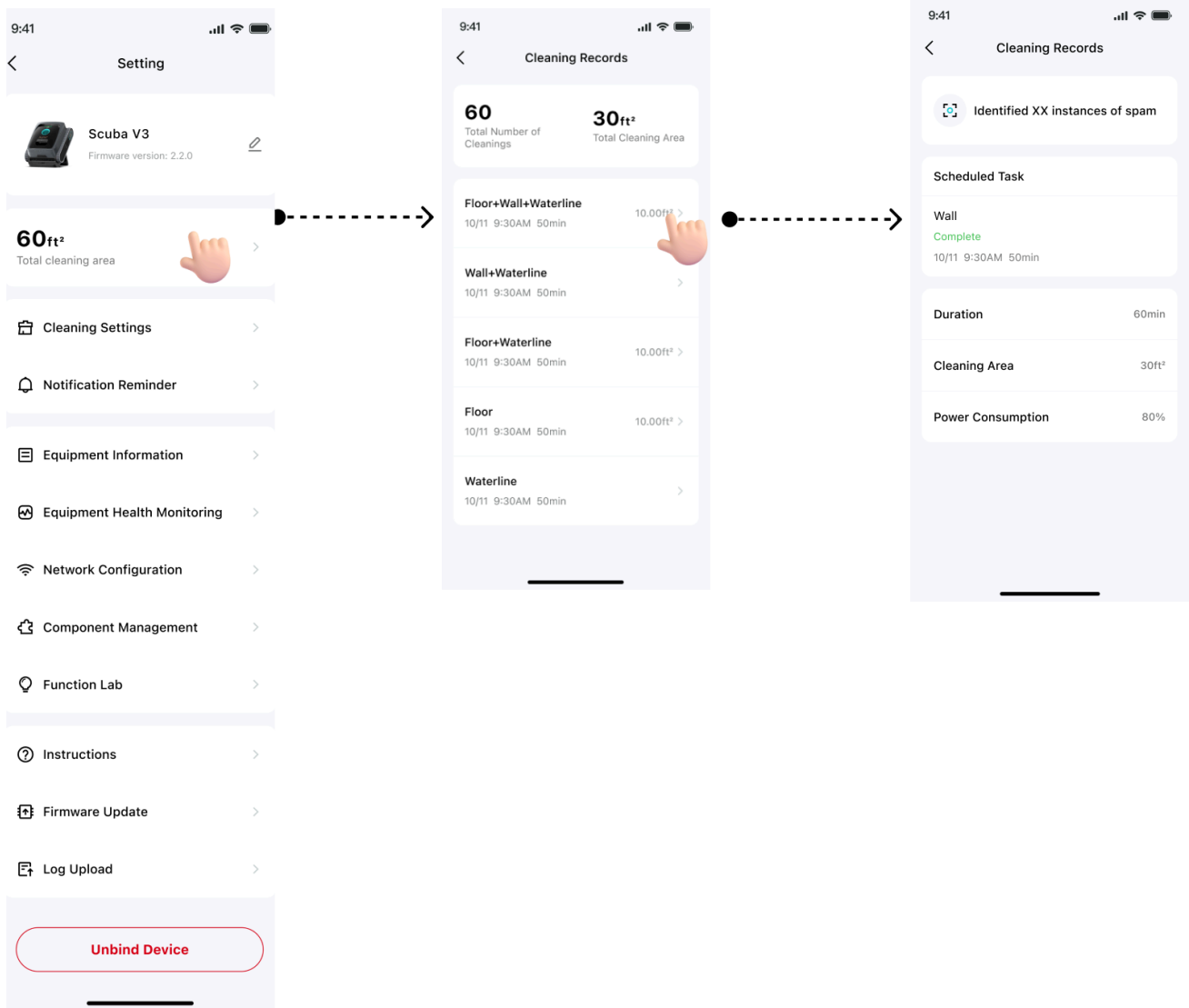
3.3 Notification Reminders

Go to Notification Reminders where you can turn reminders on or off and set the reminder time period.

3.5 Firmware Upgrade

You can enhance device performance, fix potential issues, or add new features through firmware updates.

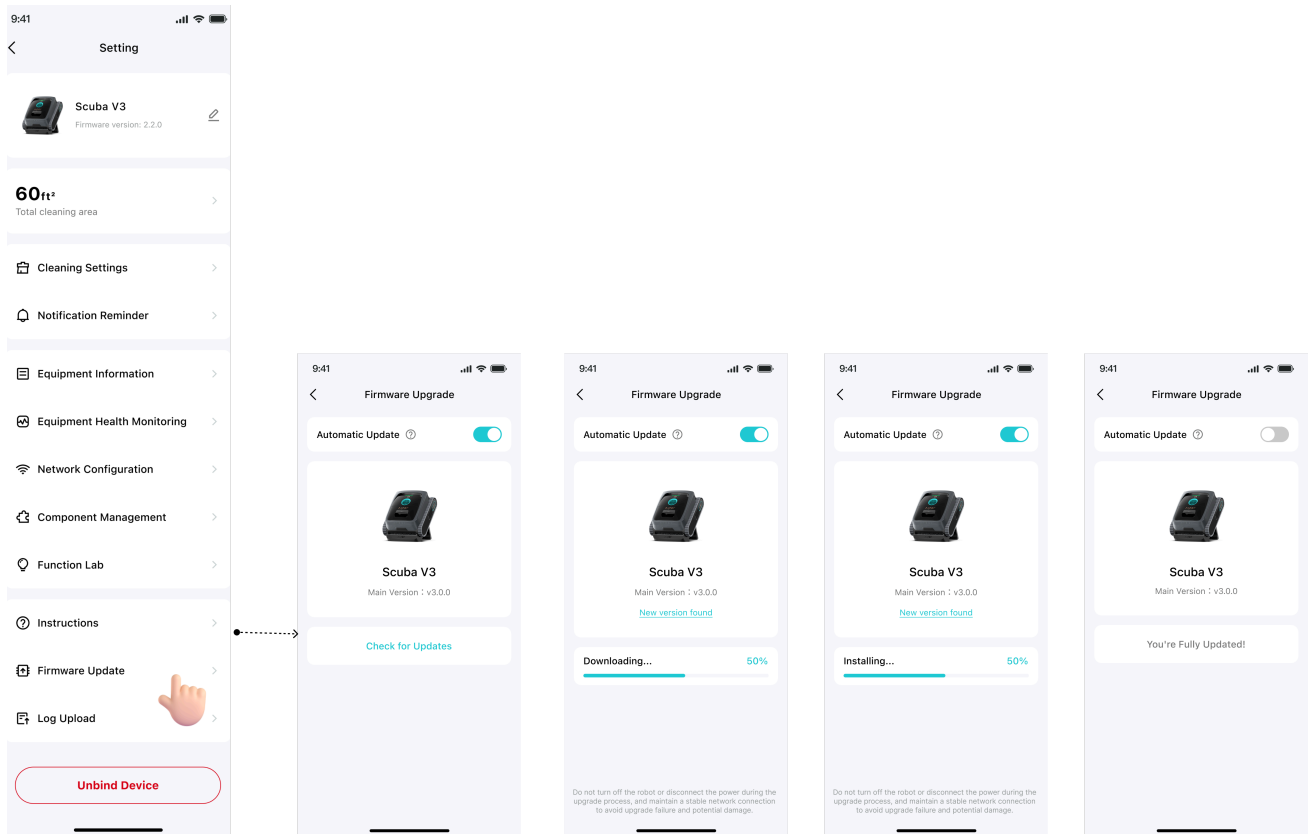
Before Upgrading

1. Ensure the robot is sufficiently charged. It is recommended to connect the robot to the power adapter before updating.
2. Keep the robot close to the router to ensure a stable network connection.

Updating the Firmware

1. Tap "Check for Updates", and the app will search for the latest firmware version available for the robot.
2. If a new version is found, tap "Download and Upgrade", and the robot will begin upgrading automatically.

⚠ Caution: Do not turn off the robot or disconnect the power during the upgrade process, and maintain a stable network connection to avoid upgrade failure and potential damage.



3.6 Log Upload

Here you can upload device logs for troubleshooting. After entering a description of the issue, tap Upload Log and wait for the upload to complete.
